Southern Railway issued the block lettering for REA originally in 1941 for use on Baggage-Express cars in service to REA. The lettering was 5 inches tall and was painted imitation gold (yellow). In 1948, Southern issued the Blueprint with the “star” for use with the REA lettering. The star was used ONLY for baggage-express cars with toilet facilities. See Blueprints SP-3364 and SP-2276
