CRESCENT LIMITED

In the late 1920s, Southern Railway Painted several heavy pacific 4-6-2, PS-4s with the Crescent Limited Paint Scheme. Instead of the normal 9 inch "Southern" on the side of the tender, the 9 inch "Crescent Limited" was used. The word Southern also appeared on the tender on the upper coal board. This lettering lasted until the middle 1930s, when Southern decided to discontinue the name train of "Crescent Limited" The lettering for Crescent Limited was Gold Leaf, and was centered on the tender sides. The letter "C" in Crescent is a "Crescent Moon" not a normal "C". The above graphics are not to any model scale, but can be resized to any scale as long as dimensions are maintained. I will provide DECAL Artwork for this lettering in scales, HO, N, O, and S.
