The monogram shown above is basically the same style early monogram used on other Southern steam locomotives with exception of color, which is black on a yellow circular background. This is the monogram used on the Southern Streamlined PS-4 Passenger engine # 1380. This monogram was 17 inches in diameter and was located on the cylinder covers on both sides of the engine, in much the same fashion as the crescent moon & stars was located on the CL engines. This drawing is not to any railroad scale, but can be resized to any scale as long as dimensions of height and width are maintained. I will provide this drawing in DECAL Scale artwork.
